
Estonian Association for Quality (EAQ)

- 1996 Honorary Member of EAQ






Walter-Masing-Preis






Quality Innovation Award



Adapted Sectoral Models in Estonian association for quality

From 2002 until nowadays the **Quality Award for Tallinn Educational Institutions** has been given to best schools and kindergartens. It is based on the EFQM EM-based and adapted to 'educational language'. Simplified categories like 'Best Learning Environement' have been developed.

In the period of 2003-2010 **Quality Award for Vocational Educational Institutions** was launched by Ministry of Science and Education and Foundation, pilot project 2003, since 2006 EFQMM-based)

In 2003 a pilot and in 2011 **Public Sector Quality Award** was run by Ministry of Finances, pilot project 2003, based on the CAF model (Common Assessment Framework) as an adaptation of EFQMM. Adapted external assessement system based on RADAR was developed.

2004-2011 **Estonian Tourism Quality Programme** was run. The adapted assessment model includes five criteria, the process is similar to EFQM C2E with additional mystery shopping visit. The project was supported by several seminars.

During 2009-2011 Quality assessment for Higher Educational Institutions was run as preparation for institutional accreditation. Self-assessment and external assessments based on adapted EFQM model, followed by a C2E-like improvement cycle. As continuation the adaptation of the model was made for continuing education offered by HEIs (HYPE project) in 2011-2013.
